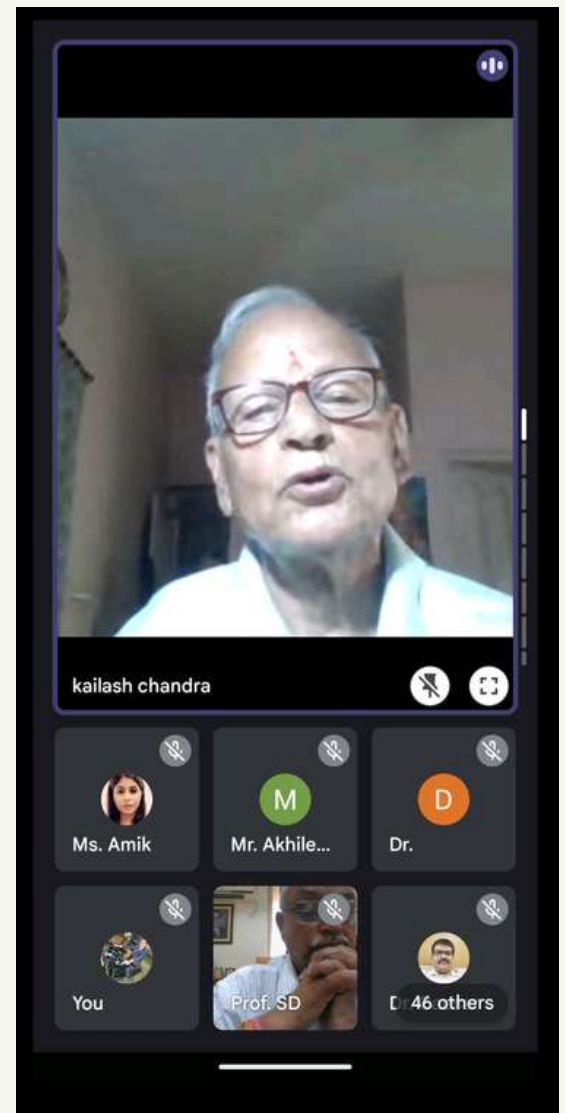
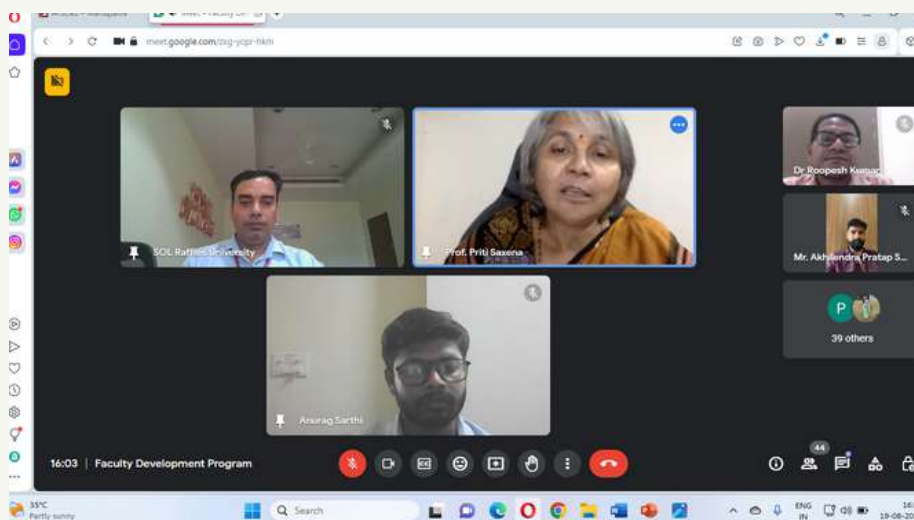
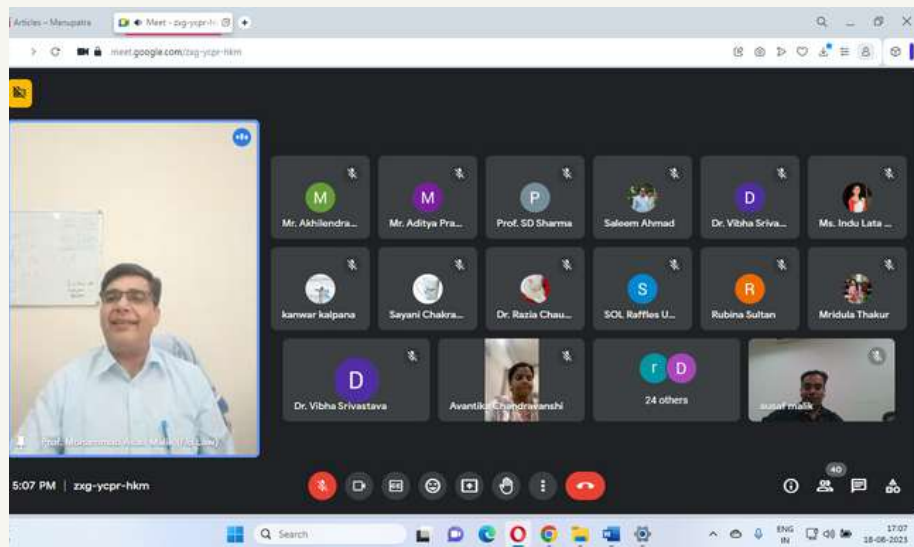
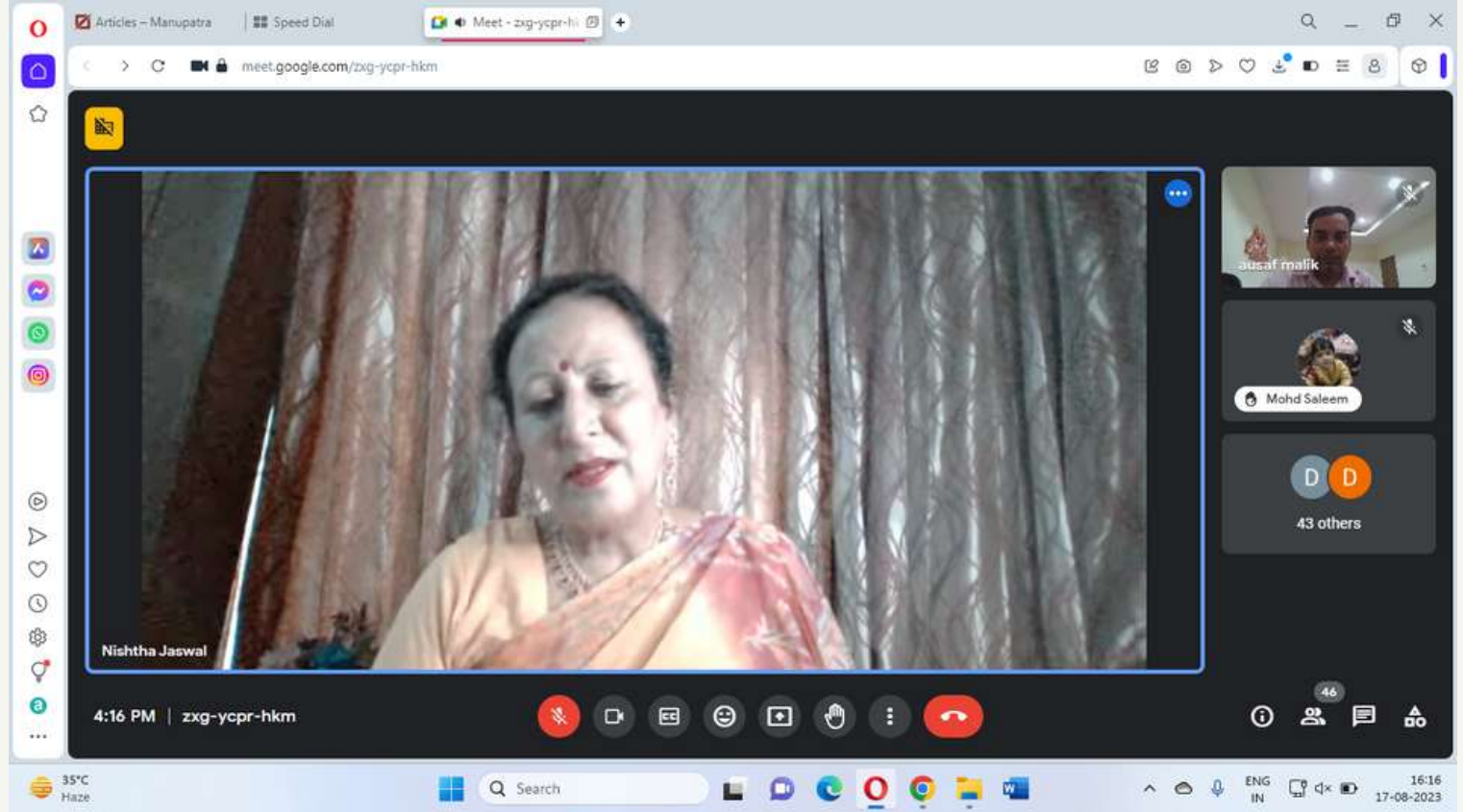


# ONE WEEK FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
