

Grace Marks Guidelines

These are the grace marks guidelines to grant grace marks to the students of Raffles University, Neemrana. These guidelines will be effective from **May 2026 examinations**.

1. Grant of grace marks is not a right of the student but it is at the discretion of the university as a compassionate consideration.
2. Two marks of grace per semester will be given to a student pursuing any program of study i.e maximum grace marks, that may be granted to a student in a subject will not be more than two per semester.
3. Grant of grace marks will be **conditional** for a student, and will be granted only if the student gets passed in the examination with the grant of the grace marks.
4. Grace marks will not be given in fractions i.e. they can be either two marks in a single subject or one mark in two subjects in a semester.
5. Un-availed grace marks (whether 1 or 2) will not be carried forward to any next semester.
6. Grace marks will be first awarded as a single mark, if it enables the student to pass the examination. Remaining one mark will be given only if it enables the student to pass, else it will lapse. For example, if a student has 49 marks in one subject and 48 marks in other subject in a semester, then 1 mark as grace will be granted, in the subject in which the student secured 49 marks the other one mark will lapse. The option of applying 2 marks will come into picture only if a student does not pass the exam in a subject with the grant of single grace marks but does pass the same with the grant of two marks. If the student secures 49 marks in two subjects in a semester, he/she granted two marks of grace as one mark each enabling him/her to get passed in the two subjects.
7. If a student secures **49 marks in more than two subjects in a semester**, grace marks shall be awarded in **two subjects only**. The selection of these subjects shall be based on the **examination date sheet**, with grace marks applied on the basis of date of examination -first exam -first serve basis.
8. If a student gets passed with grace marks even for once, his/her name/candidature will not be considered for any recognition or award etc. that has examination score/grades as the basis.
9. The grace marks will be awarded only in main exams of Theory or Practical or both and will not be granted in mid semester and any supplementary exam result.
